Dear Parent/Carer,

Another busy week in which we have been working hard in school to think about how we are all unique and celebrate our differences. This week was National Anti-Bullying Week and so each class took time to reflect upon what this means. Examples of learning can be found on our website on the pupil pages.

Many things at present are not how we would expect and we have to adapt to a 'new normal'. Certain routines/phrases have become part of everyday life...Bubbles, Social Distance etc. and we have had to change the way things are done such as 'Phone call Parent Evenings'.

Virtual Assemblies

At School we have installed software to enable us to have 'Virtual' celebration assemblies and held our first assembly today. It was lovely to be able to see each other, share prayers and celebrate. We hope to be able to hold a regular Celebrations Assembly in this way.

Parent App "Seesaw"- Class 2 Trial

As we aren't able to communicate in the usual way and share learning as perhaps we have done before such as through 'Wonderful Work Weeks' or Assemblies we will be trialling an App "*Seesaw*" with Class 2. This will enable us to see how it works and take feedback before hopefully offering this to the whole school.

The purpose of this is to give you an insight into your child's learning. It may be simply a shared photograph or a mini blurb of what pupils have been up to.

It <u>WILL NOT</u> be a means of communicating with staff and is not to be used for this purpose. Staff will not respond to questions or comments raised via the app but are, as ever, available via telephone and /or email.

We would ask that is it treated and celebrated as a way for you to share your child's learning journey and ask that families respect confidentiality and are reminded of GDPR.

As class 2 will trial the app Mrs. Sullivan will send information home and invite you to sign up. This is a free app and designed to be used on your phone. Obviously Class Photographs may be shared and as such will have other pupils as well as your own child on. Parents are once more reminded to treat these images appropriately.

Class 2 Parents only at this stage will need to contact Mrs. Sullivan on <u>Sullivan@lea-st-marys.lancs.sch.uk</u> to consent

Please email simply stating either that you wish for your child to be included or you do not wish for your child to be included.

I will share additional information following our trial in due course. I hope you really enjoy this opportunity.
