ible & able words - suffix means '**can be**' for example: **edible** - can be eaten, **enjoyable** can be enjoyed

Rules

- If you remove -able from a word, you are left with a complete word e.g. renewable is renew without the -able suffix.
- If you remove -ible from a word, you are not left with a complete word e.g. sensible without the -ible suffix is sens - not a complete word.
- But be aware that accessible, contemptible, digestible, flexible and suggestible are among the exceptions to this rule.
