- 3. Create an information poster about the Anglo Saxons including the information from the above website and an area about the Anglo Saxons that you researched yourself.

Steps to success in your information poster:

- Use a heading for your information poster and split your facts into sections under subheading eg. Anglo Saxon Villages
- Add pictures and diagrams to help the reader understand your information.
- Use noun phrases and extended noun phrases to describe the Anglo Saxons.
- Use complex sentences to make your writing more interesting (using the subordinate conjunctions whilst, when, as, since, after, although, before, because).
- Use different sentence starters to engage the reader.
- Remember to add colour and set your poster out in an exciting way!
