Thu- Make a glossary of the words. It is important that you know exactly what the words mean so that you can use them in your writing. Use this website Thesaurus and Word Tools | WordHippo select -meaning of- from the drop-down menu and create a glossary for each of your words. Can you then use them in a sentence?

Fri- Practise making pyramid words with the spellings. Remember write the first letter, then the first two, then the first three and so on. You could have a spelling test if there is someone at home to help you but it is more important that you have practised! I will be really proud of anyone who has practised the words each day! 
Geography
