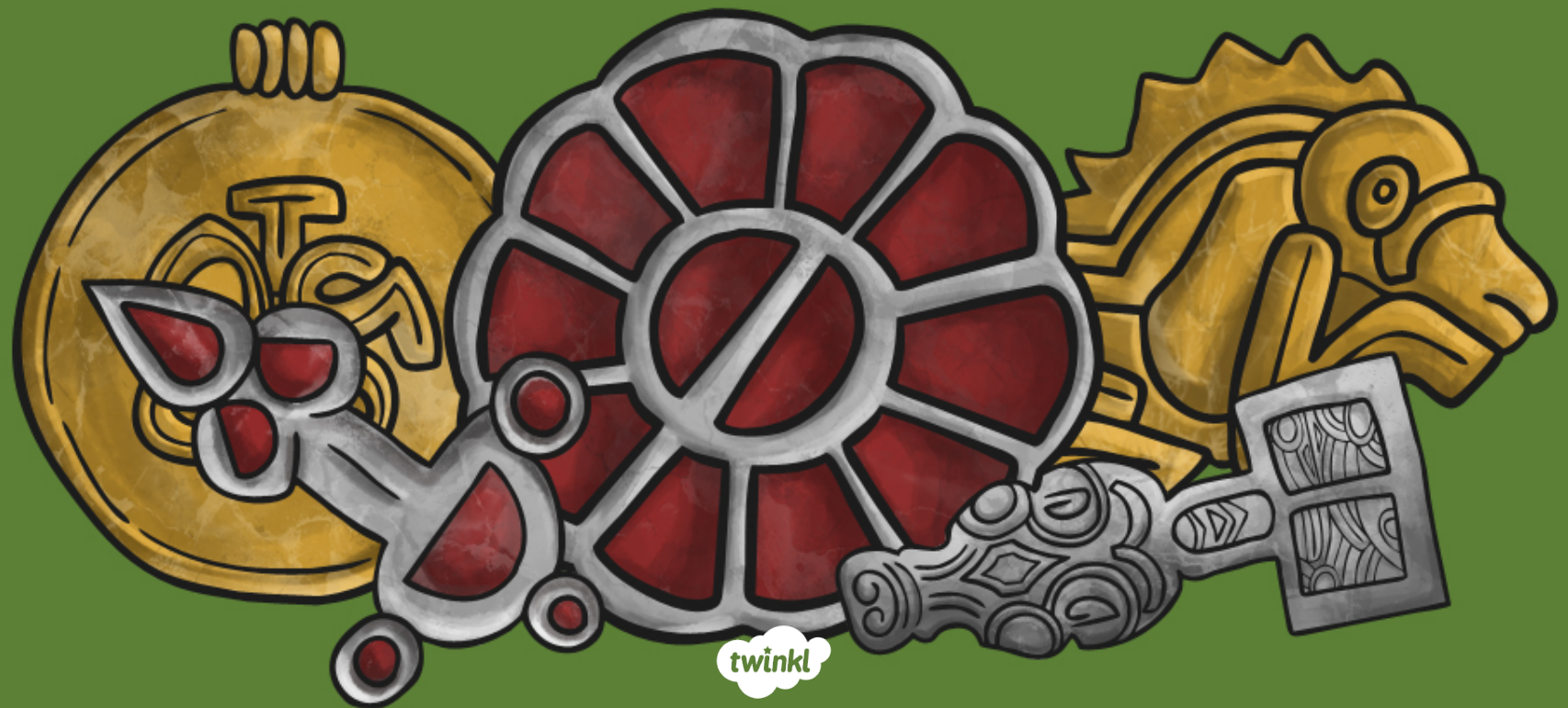


Anglo-Saxons and Scots Artefacts and Culture

- We can examine the relationships and interactions between Anglo-Saxon groups and societies and compare and contrast them with how we live today.

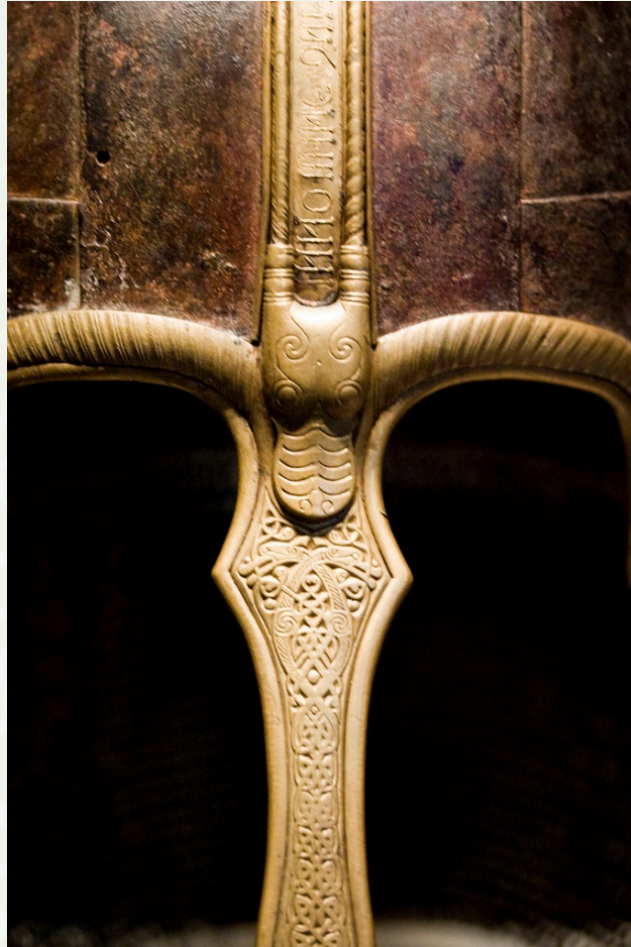
