**Hotter-** Retell the story in role as one of the disciples. What did you think when Jesus said he would have to go and that he would be betrayed?

**Hottest-** Retell the story in an interesting and engaging way. Once completed answer these challenge questions-

How did Jesus know he was going to die? Why do you think Judas betrayed Jesus? Do you think Jesus disciples truly understood what Jesus was telling them? What part of the mass is like the last supper? Explain.
