### Regular Tasks

- Year 1 - Practise writing the numbers 1 - 20 every day.
- All children - Read a book to a grown up.
- Year 1 - Practise reading the tricky words ( at the bottom of the page) Can you have a go at writing the tricky words up to phase 4?
- All children - Keep a short diary, what have you enjoyed playing with at home today? Have you played in the garden? Have you made up any new games or created something new with construction toys?
