Sacramental Preparation

We are really looking forward to meeting the children and starting their preparations. The first session will take place at the Church Annex on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> February at 3.15pm. The first three sessions will focus upon First Reconciliation (First Confession).

The remaining dates are as follows;

Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March at 3:15pm

Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March at 3:15pm – The pupils will make their First Reconciliation which will focus on First Holy Communion. <u>Please could we ask that parents attend this session.</u>

The last three sessions will focus on First Holy Communion
Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> March at 3:15pm - 5.15 -Church Annex extended session
Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> March 3:15pm - Church Annex cancelled session
Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> April 3:15pm - Church Annex

These sessions will start straight after school, we will collect the pupils from school and walk them over to church. At 4:20pm they are to be collected from the annex, the meeting room behind church. The children will be greeted with a drink of juice and biscuits.

Pupils will make their First Holy Communion <u>Sunday 21st April 9.00am Mass St Mary's</u> followed by Communion Breakfast in the school hall.
