These sessions will start straight after school, we will collect the pupils from school and walk them over to church. At 4:20pm they are to be collected from the annex, the meeting room behind church. The children will be greeted with a drink of juice and biscuits.

Pupils will make their First Holy Communion <u>Sunday 21st April 9.00am Mass St Mary's</u> followed by Communion Breakfast in the school hall.
