EXPLORE

Engage in activities, explore possibilities, show curiosity, show interest and persevere.

Example: Sarah was excited about her Egypt topic she visited the library to chose some new books and used her lpad to research

Bobby played with lego bricks sorting them into colours, sizes and orders.



ACTIVE

Focus, concentrate, be fascinated, persist, bounce back if tricky or make mistakes, be proud



Example: Clare found the Maths calculations tricky at first but kept trying and practising. She asked for support with an example and completed the rest independently never giving up.

John made some mistakes with his spellings but practised these every day until he was sure showing great concentration.

THINK CREATIVELY

Think of ideas, solve problems, make links, test ideas, review methods.

Example: Peter helped make cakes for 6 people despite the recipe being for 12. He was able to recognise he would have to halve the numbers to adjust the recipe

Laura helped set the table for tea working out how many knives, forks and placemats would be needed.
