On Wednesday Class 1 made Bibles - Jesus is in the Bible - Freddie Pye





<u>SVP – Minnie Vinnie Packs</u>



When Ella from Cottam SVP came to talk to us on Tuesday she left us with some challenges. Class 4 were given a Mini-Vinnie pack which contains cold weather essentials and toiletries to be given to a rough sleeper to help them throughout the cold weather. The children have been encouraged to talk about and show these to you so that as a family you can offer some help to a person in need. The children have been told that they must not act alone in this and that an adult must be with them.

Class 3 were given a prayer card for someone who lives alone and might be lonely. Their challenge was to give the card to someone they, or their family think might need it.

Classes 1 and 2 were challenged with praying for classes 3 and 4 to support them with these challenges.

Parking
