We have had a lovely week in school with a bit of Spring sunshine breaking through. It has been lovely to see all the amazing costumes today in school as we celebrated World Book Day.





### Coronavirus

As we shared with you the Information regarding the Coronavirus is regularly being updated by the Department for Health. ## Mobile Phones in school

A reminder, Pupils are not permitted to use Mobile phones/ electronic devices in school. We recognise on rare occasions that you may wish for your child to bring a phone for example if travelling alone on the bus/ walking home alone. In these exceptional circumstances pupils must hand their phones into the office at the start of the school day and they must be remain turned off. They will be returned at the end of the school day and may not be used at all whilst on school grounds, even after school hours. If pupils do not follow our school rules the behaviour policy will apply.

We thank you for continuing to support us to safeguard pupils. As I am sure you will be aware pupils can use such devices to access online sites, apps and games and we cannot be responsible for their online safety.

Many apps/ Sites such as Tik-Tok, Instagram and Facebook have age restrictions and to Safeguard pupils we, as a school, would not allow access to these.
