Big School Adventures begins 5th November 2020

Our First Big School Adventures session will run from Thursday 5th of November from 1.15 -3.15 pm. As ever, safety is of paramount importance so pre booking for the session is essential and numbers will be strictly limited.

We would ask that pupils bring wellies, a waterproof suit in a carrier bag and wear suitable clothing for sports activities (e.g. track suit, trainers).

The first hour of the session will be led by a professional coach who specialises in Pre-School and Early Years sports activities. The second session pupils will be 'Outdoor Explorers' and complete Forest School type activities.

Big School Adventure children will be greeted by a staff member, supported to wash their hands and brought through to the classroom for the fun to begin!!

Bags in school.

As per previous newsletters, for the safety and wellbeing of all we are working to reduce the amount of items that travel between Home and School. Pupils do not at present require bags in school. No items from home such as stationery should be brought in. All pupils are provided with individual resources. Pupils will require coats, a water bottle and are welcome to bring a personal sanitiser gel into school. Only water is permitted in drinking bottles and we ask that water bottles have a sports cap.

Lunches and Snacks

School continues to offer two choices of lunches every day, full menus can be found on the school website on the home page (link to the Menus are on the left hand side).

For break time snacks it is school policy that pupils have a healthy snack only, such as a piece of fruit. Chocolate and crisps are **not** permitted.

For Packed lunches brought in from home, school policy is that lunches are healthy and balanced. Pupils should not have fizzy pop and/ or large chocolate bar and / or packets of sweets. Thank you for continuing to work in partnership.

Extra curricular clubs

As I have previously shared, we have had a number of enquiries in regard to the After School Club and when this may re-open. Whilst I appreciate that is very difficult for some families not to have this provision we have to be guided by Government and County Council advice and at present, as you will be aware, Locally, Preston is classified as Tier 3. It is therefore imperative we take all the safety measures we can....A key measure being that we cannot cross Bubbles, so at present we cannot run our After School Club. We will, as ever, keep you updated.

After half term we will offer 'Bubble' clubs. These clubs will be delivered by professional coaches and each class 'Bubble' will be given the chance to attend a club. Each class has been given the opportunity to vote for the sport they would like.

Important Safety Advice

We have asked families NOT to allow pupils to play on the grassed area in front of Church. This is out of respect given the fact the Nuns may be in prayer and to ensure pupils do not cross Bubbles.

- Pupils/ family members should not enter school grounds if they demonstrate ANY symptoms
- Bubbles open at 8.45 and 9.00 am and close at 3.00 and 3.15 pm. Please adhere strictly to times. We cannot be flexible in these times.
- At collection time only one adult should enter the school grounds
- Should you need to contact a staff member please email/ telephone school
- Please park on the Smith's Arms pub and walk down to school at your allocated time
- Please wait in the car, when possible, until your child's Bubble time
- Do not gather around the school grounds and remember Social Distancing
- Once your child has been received into the playground we ask families to leave the school area rather than waiting to wave pupil in- This is for everyone's safety
- Pupils are not permitted to play on the equipment before or after school

Free School Meals - Absence from school due to COVID-19

If your child is absent from school due to COVID-19, and they are currently eligible for free schools meals <u>based on the household income</u>, the school kitchen will be able to provide a packed lunch for your child.
