Learning about God and his teachings.

We would like to share with you what your child is learning in Religious Education. This information will be shared with you each half term.

Class 1: Families and Celebrations

We will learn what it means to belong to the family called the Church. We will also explore special celebrations that take place in church, including Baptism and Christmas.



Class 3: Mary Our Mother

We will be looking at the story of Mary our Mother and the sacrifices she made for us many years ago and the impact this has had on our own lives and religion.

Class 2: Mary, Mother of God

We will learn that Mary is the mother of our school, heaven and the Church. Through careful study of the lead up to the nativity, we will learn how Mary inspires us to say 'yes' to God. We will also learn about the importance of the Advent season.



Class 4: The Commandments

We will be reflecting on how we need God's help, love and support to follow the Commandments. We will be analysing scripture to show how God has sent help and reflect on where our Catholic beliefs come from with regard to the Commandments.
