Parent App "Seesaw"- Trial- Class 1

As we aren't able to communicate in the usual way and share learning as perhaps we have done before such as through 'Wonderful Work Weeks' or Assemblies we will be trialling an App "Seesaw" with Class 2. This will enable us to see how it works and take feedback before hopefully offering this to the whole school.

The purpose of this is to give you an insight into your child's learning. It may be simply a shared photograph or a mini blurb of what pupils have been up to.

It <u>WILL NOT</u> be a means of communicating with staff and is not to be used for this purpose. Staff will not respond to questions or comments raised via the app but are, as ever, available via telephone and /or email.

We would ask that is it treated and celebrated as a way for you to share your child's learning journey and ask that families respect confidentiality and are reminded of GDPR.

Obviously Class Photographs may be shared and as such will have other pupils as well as your own child on. Parents are once more reminded to treat these images appropriately.
