On Thursday the 18th of November we will hold a REVERSE dressing up day where the pupils can be ANY staff member and the staff will dress as the pupils!!!

<u> Nativity – Classes 1 and 2</u>

Please see below in our Diary dates section the dates and proposed times for our Nativity. We are delighted to be able to share this experience with families as I know how hard it was for everyone not to hold this special tradition last year due to Covid. As you will appreciate we can only make 'plans' but will have to monitor local and National requirements as we move towards December.

At present it is our plan, in order to keep numbers manageable and account for differing comfort levels, to hold showings over two days. The first date will be offered ONLY to class 1 families and the second date ONLY to class 2 families. We share these dates in

advance so you can make the necessary plans and arrangements to attend. In order to ensure we have clear pre planned numbers attending and that we are fair and equal to ALL families, every child will be issued with two afternoon and two evening tickets. **We cannot issue any additional tickets or swap days or times.**

In line with guidance as we are in an enclosed space we would ask that families attending wear a face covering unless they have a medical exemption.

For the 4pm showing pupils will stay in school and we will provide them all with a drink and snack . Staff will ensure they are safely handed back to you once changed at the end of the performance.

I thank you in advance for your support and understanding. We have worked hard to plan and risk assess so our Nativity can take place. The main thing is we are able to share this Nativity with you and that the children take part in this Christmas tradition. We will record the performance and share this on our website too!

Frequently Asked Questions

My child has Coronavirus symptoms what should I do?

Telephone the School Office to advise your child will not be attending as they are symptomatic and book a PCR test at a test centre. Once this result is returned share this with school via email. If the test is negative and the pupil remains well they may return to school.

If my Child demonstrated Coronavirus symptoms in school what will happen?

You will be contacted and advised you need to collect your child and book a PCR test. Your child will remain at home until they are fit and well and able to share their Negative result.

We do not have to isolate anymore do we?

Bubbles at school are removed and as such, if your child has been in contact with a positive person at school, the whole Bubble will no longer be required to isolate for 10 days. All 'Close Contacts' will be required to take a PCR test and, if this is negative, they may return to school.

NHS Track and Trace will work with families to identify 'Close Contacts'. I would strongly encourage you to liaise with school so we can support you with this and reduce the spread. As you will appreciate staff will be best placed to identify pupils who have sat together, played together etc. etc.

At present, as we are working with Public Health England myself or Mr. Taylor will call families of Direct Contacts to inform them they need to seek a PCR.

I have a box of Lateral Flow kits at home can I just use this?

No, you would have to have a PCR result

Someone in my household is positive. Can my child attend school?

We would require the pupil to seek a PCR test and share this result with school via email. If the pupil is negative please remember that this is a negative result at the point of the test and your child could still develop Coronavirus within the Isolation period. We would strongly encourage a daily Lateral Flow Test and ask families to reflect upon the risks to other pupils and staff within school. We want to work in partnership to ensure we keep each other safe and are grateful for your support.
