



Curriculum RE

Learning about God and his teachings.

We would like to share with you what your child is learning in Religious Education. This information will be shared with you each half term.

Class 1: God's Family

The children will know that they are special within their family and community. They will learn about ways in which a Christian family and parish share and celebrate life, and show care for one another. They will come to know that Mary is the Mother of Jesus and hear the story of Christmas.



Class 3: Trust in God

Children will learn that Jesus teaches us to have faith and trust in him. They will learn that Joseph put his trust in God when the angel appeared to him and that God fulfilled his promise to Mary when Jesus was born.

Below are the three assessment focuses for RE and the skill areas the children will develop. The topics for each class for this half-term are displayed on this page.

Class 2: Mysteries

The children will explore thoughts and questions that they wonder about God. They will learn about the Holy Trinity and the Christmas story. The importance of the period of Advent will be explored.



Class 4: Justice

The children will explore the concept of justice. They will learn about individuals who have been persecuted for their commitment to justice. The children will consider the importance of Advent.
