Learning about God and his teachings.

We would like to share with you what your child is learning in Religious Education. This information will be sent to you each half term.

Class 1: Sorrow and Joy

The children will begin to understand that we are capable of hurting others and that we should always try to be kind to each other. They will learn that we can say sorry when we hurt someone but we need to ask Jesus to help us to do this. They will also begin to learn that Jesus forgave those who hurt him and know that we can forgive other people when they hurt us.



Class 3: Jesus the Saviour

The children will learn all the key events of Holy Week; Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

Class 2: The Mass

The children will learn about important parts of the church as well as the different parts of the Mass. They will reflect upon how Jesus is present in the Mass through Holy Communion.



Class 4: Jesus, Son of God

The children will learn how Jesus' miracles led many to believe he was the Son of God. They will understand why Jesus washed the disciples' feet and will learn about the Passion and Death of Jesus, reflecting on its importance for us. They will also understand and reflect on what the resurrection of Jesus means for us.
