



# Curriculum RE

## Learning about God and his teachings.

We would like to share with you what your child is learning in Religious Education. This information will be sent to you each half term.

### **Class 1: Resurrection**

We will know that Jesus appeared again to his disciples and how he helped them to understand that he was truly alive. We will learn that Jesus returned to Heaven after forty days and reflect on the promises he made.



### **Class 3: Celebrating Easter and Pentecost**

We will explore how the Church celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus. We will learn about how Jesus appeared to some of his friends after he rose from the dead. Children will develop an understanding of how the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost changed the disciples and reflect on times when we need help.

Below are the three assessment focuses for RE and the skill areas the children will develop. The topics for each class for this half-term are displayed on this page.

### **Class 2: Resurrection**

We will learn about the different times when Jesus appeared to his disciples and reflect upon what this means for us. We will learn about Jesus returning into Heaven after forty days.



### **Class 4: Life in the Risen Lord**

We will know and understand that Jesus is risen from the dead. We will learn that the risen Jesus is present among us in different ways. We will know that there are different ways of praying and reflect on Jesus' teaching and example on prayer. We will learn to understand the Our Father and learn how to pray the Rosary.
