



Learning about the Bible and Jesus.

We would like to share with you what your child is learning in Religious Education. This information will be sent to you each half term.

Class 1: Getting to know Jesus

We will know that Jesus is a special person in the Bible and that he teaches us how to share God's love. We will learn about what he did and how he helped other people he met.



Class 3: The Bible

We will explore how the Bible is divided into different chapters. We will learn about the Old Testament and New Testament. We will find out about different stories in the Old and New Testament.

We will begin to find Bible and Scripture references with help.

We will learn and discuss what the Kingdom of God looks like. We will discuss whether we are worthy to enter the Kingdom of God. We will discuss where the Kingdom of God is on Earth.
