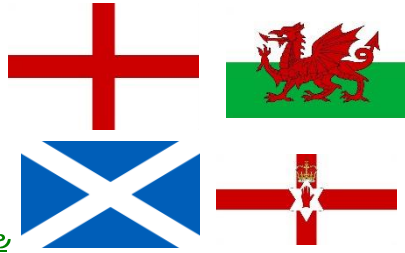

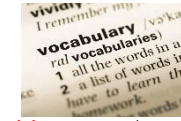
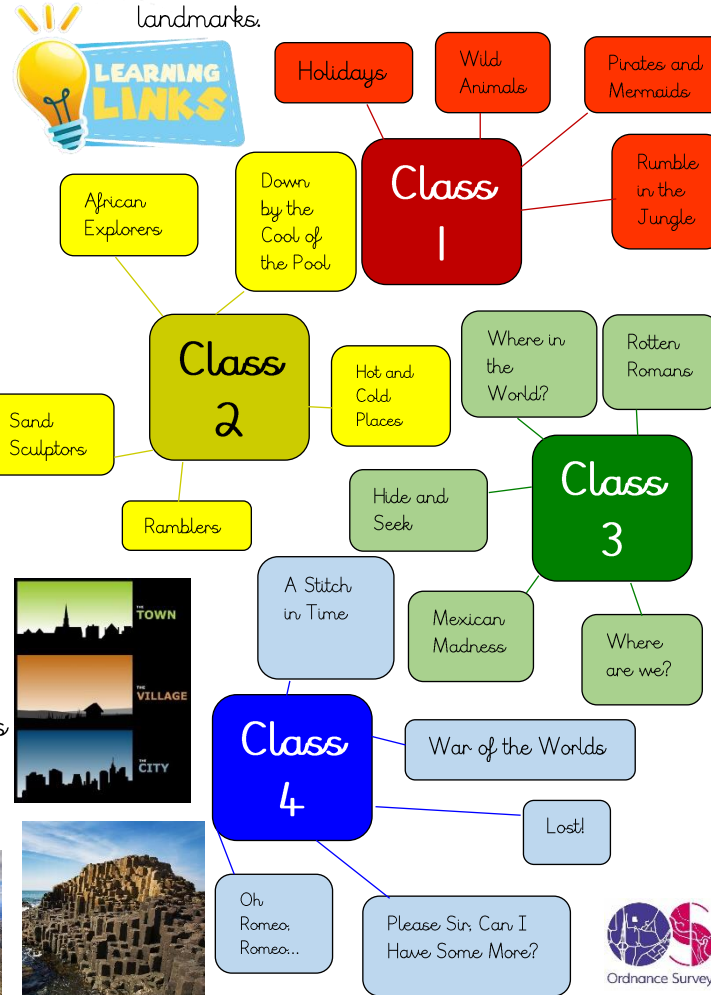


## BIG Idea



The UK is made up of the island of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. It is surrounded by the English Channel, the North Sea, the Irish Sea and the North Atlantic Ocean. Each country that makes up the UK has a capital and its own landmarks.

- ✓ There are 4 countries that make up The United Kingdom (UK)- England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
- ✓ There are 4 seas/oceans surrounding The UK- Atlantic Ocean, North Sea, Irish Sea and English Channel.
- ✓ Each country in the UK has its own capital city- England (London), Scotland (Edinburgh), Wales (Cardiff) and Northern Ireland (Belfast).
- ✓ Each country has its own National Flag- see pictures.
- ✓ There are many human and physical geographical features in each country, such as buildings, roads, hills, mountains and rivers.
- ✓ There are both pros and cons for living in either a village, town or city.
- ✓ Village - Town - City
- ✓ There are many landmarks in each country of the UK- England (Big Ben, Tower Bridge, Stonehenge, Buckingham Palace), Scotland (Edinburgh Castle, Holyrood House, Loch Ness), Wales (Mount Snowdon, Snowdonia National Park) and Northern Ireland (Giant's Causeway, Belfast Castle).
- ✓ London has a population of around 9 million people.



## Vocabulary

- Map-** a diagram showing the place where you are.
- OS map-** a map of an area showing human and physical features on it.
- Leisure-** time away from work.
- Tourists-** a person who visits a place away from where they live.
- Atlas-** a book/collection of maps.
- Compass-** a device used to tell the direction.
- Digital Map-** a map seen on a mobile device.
- Ordnance Survey Maps (OS Maps)-** a British company who create up-to-date maps of areas in the UK.
- Symbols-** a picture to represent something.
- Human Features-** buildings/objects created by humans.
- Physical Features-** natural objects/places created by nature.
- Town-** a place where people live and work. It is bigger than a village, but smaller than a city.
- Countryside-** land that is not in a town or city. It is usually surrounded by farmland and woods.
- Country-** an area of land with its own Government, rules and borders.
- UK-** The United Kingdom. Made up of 4 countries- England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
- Island-** an area of land surrounded by water.
- Capital City-** a town or city where the Government sits.
- Landmark-** a feature of a place that is easily recognised.
- Population-** how many people live in the area.
