Population- how many people live in the area.





- ✓ There are 4 countries that make up The United Kingdom (UK) - England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Treland
- ✓ There are 4 seas/oceans surrounding The UK- Atlantic Ocean, North Sea, Irish Sea and English Channel.
- ✓ Each country in the UK has its own capital city-England (London), Scotland (Edinburgh), Wales (Cardiff) and Northern Ireland (Belfast).
- ✓ Each country has its own National Flag-see pictures.
- ✓ There are many human and physical geographical features in each country, such as buildings, roads, hills, mountains and rivers.
- ✓ There are both pros and cons for living in either a village, town or city.
- ✓ Village Town City
- ✓ There are many landmarks in each country of the UK-England (Big Ben, Tower Bridge, Stonehenge, Buckingham Palace), Scotland (Edinburgh Castle, Holyrood House, Loch Ness), Wales (Mount Snowdon, Snowdonia National Park) and Northern Ireland (Giant's Causeway, Belfast Castle).
