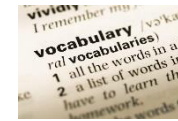
Sticky Knowledge

- ✓ Europe is made up of 43 different countries.
- ✓ The largest country in Europe is Russia.
- ✓ The smallest country in Europe is Vatican City.
- ✓ Russia's population is around 144 million.
- ✓ Vatican City's population is 825.
- ✓ The UK population is around 67 million.
