- ✓ The Pacific Ocean is the largest ocean in the world.

- ✓ Human features are made and built by humans e.g. buildings, roads, motorways, towns, cities.
- ✓ A dairy farm has cows which are used to produce milk, which is also used to produce dairy products.
- ✓ An arable farm is a farm which only grows crops such as barley and wheat.
- ✓ A mixed farm has facilities to produce crops and cows to produce milk.
- ✓ A biome describes what a place is like and has its own specific climate e.g. aquatic, grassland, forest, desert, and tundra
- ✓ A vegetation belt refers to the plant and plant life within a biome.

Crops- a plant which is grown to harvest and used to make a profit from.

Import- something that is brought into a country or place.

Equator- the imaginary line around the centre of the Earth

Country/countries- a nation occupying a place within the World which has its own Government.

Maps- a representation of an area.

Digital- a computerised version of something. Aerial- a view from above 'a bird's eye view'.

Atlas- a book containing many maps.

Globe- a representation of the Earth.

Dairy farming- a farm which only raises cows to produce milk

Arable farming- a farm which only grows crops such as barley and wheat.

Mixed farming- a farm which has both crops and livestock on it.

Fair Trade- a scheme created to ensure farmers/growers are paid a fair wage for their crops. Biomes- a place with a specific climate and surroundings.

Vegetation belts- the plant life within a biome. Agriculture- cultivating the land, growing crops and raising livestock to earn a wage.

Hemisphere- half of a sphere/half of the earth-Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere. Wage- an amount of money earnt for working.
