Change of school day... DfE requirements

As you may remember the DfE Proposed a change to school days to ensure that all school openings equated to 32.5 hours. Some schools chose to implement this change this academic year and the Government then changed the effective from date to September 24.

At St Mary's, this would mean increasing our school day by 10 minutes effective September 24. This realistically gives us two options:-

Starting at 8.45 (rather than 8.55) or finishing at 3.25 (rather than 3.15).

As a staff, we thought 8.45 would make sense as we greet pupils from that time daily anyway, and bring them into school. This focused slot could be used to enhance learning (Fluency, intensive reading, phonics, fix its etc.)
