E.A.T. Passports- Exciting Homework challenge !!!



EAT Learning and Passports to Learning, have been established at St Mary's for over 3 years now, with children being given opportunities to engage in a wide range of activities, skills and experiences to enhance their skills, develop their knowledge and share in a variety of experiences with their peers, whilst at school.

EAT Learning stands for:

- **E Explore Explore** learning, Have a go and persevere
- A Active be Active and independent within their learning
- T Think creatively!

Within each class, each child will have the opportunity to take part in these experiences within school and, using their passport, create a record of the activities they have completed, either at home or within school.

As each child leaves in Year 6, they will be presented with their Learning Passport as a memento/reminder of the learning experiences they have had whilst at St Mary's.

For homework this half term, each child is being given a copy of their Passport to Learning for them to complete at home with their family. They can send in photographs, drawings, sketches or objects, inside the plastic wallet, that link to their passport challenges to share with the class and record this in their passports in school, when we return after our break.
