On 26th June 1666, William Mompesson suggested that Eyam should be quarantined in order to stop the plague spreading to other areas. This meant that no one was allowed to enter or leave the village. Other villages brought food and other supplies to Eyam, leaving them at the entrance to the village. Church services were held outside, with family groups standing at a distance from other families. Families buried their own dead.
