Roof repairs at School in the new year.

In the new year, we shall be starting repairs on our roof at the rear of school. The works are funded through a grant we successfully achieved, but works were delayed as we found out we have bats roosting in the loft space! It seems we have several maternal roosts!

I have met with all contractors and those protecting the bats and works are planned to cause minimal disruption to pupils. The intend work is to commence in our first week back. Rigorous safety measures are in place for scaffolding and the fencing off of areas and this should not have impact on the day-to-day access of school.



Arbor

As you know as we are now within Mater Ecclesiae Multi Academy Trust we will migrate to a system called Arbor. Initially we will take registers on the system and as we progress Arbor will be our cashless payment methods and will be used for booking After School/ Breakfast clubs etc.
