Arbor



Arbor is now up and running for all classroom registers and for the payment of school meals. As we have communicated by Text, we will no longer be able to accept cash payments – In line with LCC guidance School Dinners will increase to £2.90 per day from w/c 26.1.26.

After February half term, we will only take booking and payments for Breakfast and After School Club via Arbor. Booking will 'go live' from w/c 2.2.26

From 24.2.26 in order to support families' late pick will be extended to 4.00pm and offered at the revised price of £5.00.

Here are some FAQ's about Arbor.

How will I receive instructions about logging onto Arbor?

Arbor will have automatically sent all families an email with setting up instructions. The email expires so please check your inbox, spam and junk boxes as soon as you are able.

I haven't received my email from Arbor what can I do?

Check your spam and junk folders and if you are still unable to find an email please contact us at school. The email will have automatically been sent to the email address on file. If you have changed your email and not informed us it may be that the email we hold is out of date. Please share the appropriate email address with us as soon as possible.

Can both Parents/Carers have access to Arbor?

Yes - If both parents have different email addresses, the invite letter will have automatically been issued. If you have only shared one parent/ Carer email at the time your child joined school and wish to add on a second email address please, contact the school office.

If families have two email addresses and/or live in separate households, they can both access the same information, both make payments and view information.
